2019-20 DISTRICT GOALS

1. St. David Unified School District will show growth Reading, Writing, and Mathematics as measured by Galileo: At least 75% of the students will demonstrate growth as measured by Galileo Metrics.

- Implement and analyze district benchmark assessments— (Pre and Post Tests—Teacher will have the option of a mid-test to gauge performance)
- Provide remediation and enrichment for identified students – (Elementary-After School/In-School, High School 11:30-11:50)
- Provide professional development in reading for information in non-fictional text and evidenced based writing.

2. Maintain a safe, structured and positive school environment that will foster excellence in student achievement.

- Character Counts instruction and recognition
- Positive Recognitions and celebrations
- Improve communication with staff and parents—Use of Student information system (Teacher Vue and Parent Vue), Website, Social Media and Text Messaging, Introduction of teacher/class webpages.
- Additional Security Cameras
- Emergency Response Plan (updated)-Additional Emergency drills (ALICE-Active Shooter), Installation of devices to help secure a door →Teacher/Student relationships (Mentor program in grades 6-12)
- Proactive communication with students about current performance and achievement.
- Implement additional Honors Classes (English 9 and World History) and an Honors Diploma.

3. Provide all students with effective teachers and Principals through professional learning opportunities in order to close achievement gaps.

- Recruitment and Placement of highly qualified teachers and principal
- Retention of highly qualified teachers-Staff Climate/recognitions
- Professional Development provided to all teachers on district half -days.
- Monthly Data Team meetings
- Continued implementation and monitoring of the new Teacher/Principal evaluation focusing on Student Growth.
- Required colleague classroom visits.

4. Maintain a 95% or better Graduation Rate for the 2019 Cohort.

- Staff will monitor and identify all students that are in jeopardy of failing to be promoted or to graduate.
- All students will be provided a mentor. (Grades 6-12)
- Provide remediation and credit recovery. High School remediation time will be between 11:30-11:50

5. Improve public awareness and foster relationships that will increase stakeholder support measured through an 85% approval rating on annual survey.

- Maintain and improve the delivering of information to stakeholders
- Focus on Social Media and Public Relation image
- Create an online newsletter that celebrates success and promotes involvement
- Exemplary Customer service by ensuring all stakeholders feel welcome on campus, responding to all communication within 24hrs, and creation of a system to receive information from stakeholders.
