Dear parents of Kindergarten students,

With all the changes in the past few months in healthcare, some of our routine appointments and well child checks have been delayed. This is just a friendly reminder from the St. David School District Health Office that in order to attend Kindergarten there are few required immunizations. The typical needed doses are **DTap** (**Tetanus**), **Polio**, **MMR**(measles, mumps, and rubella) and Varicella (Chicken Pox). There are possible variations depending on catch-up schedules, etc. These vaccinations are required for all Kindergarten age children attending school. Please give this your urgent attention as we have already begun school and there will be no delays for the deadlines on reporting to the state on this. Please contact the school health office with any questions or concerns.

If you are unable to get these immunizations at your child's regular doctor, here is an option:

Health Department in Benson, 520-586-8200. Currently they are providing immunizations on the 2nd Thursday of each month by appointment only. They are full in September, so if this is the plan, please call ASAP for an appointment in October.

The local pharmacies will administer vaccinations but starting at age 8.

Obviously, the best and easiest route is through your child's regular doctor. The Benson Health Department is an option if this is not possible for any reason. Please bring in a copy of the shot record when completed or just leave us a message that they are completed and we can look it up. Thank you in advance for giving this your urgent attention.
