

RELEASE OF INFORMATION FORM

According to School Board Policy JR – Student Records, the District designates personally identifiable information contained in a student’s education record as “directory information” and will disclose that information without prior consent. If you do not want to permit the District to disclose directory information about your child, review the section below indicating which information you choose to “Opt Out” of for your child.

In addition to directory information, according to School Board Policy LC-E and the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA), it is also important to inform, that you know of your rights regarding the 1) collection, disclosure or use of personal information for marketing, sales or other distribution; 2) administration of any protected information survey not funded by the US Department of Education; and 3) any non-emergency physical examination or screening required as a condition of attendance.

If you do not complete the form the District will assume it has your permission to use the information. This designation will remain in effect through the 2011-12 school year unless it is modified by your written direction.
